



Making better teachers

The EDUCA 2015 8th Annual Congress for Teacher Professional Development returns from Oct 14-16 at Impact Forum (Hall 9), Muang Thong Thani.

The annual event is organised by the Office of the Basic Education Commission (Obec), Ministry of Education in collaboration with the Faculty of Education, Chulalongkorn University, the Association of Science and Technology Education and Pico (Thailand.

The theme this year is "On Schooling", which aims to support children's intellectual, social, emotional and civic development and to question how schooling should be transformed and changed.

The event features several activities, including an international conference to share and discuss how to transform Thai schooling by using expertise and experience of the invited keynote speakers from America, Europe and Asia.

There will be an international workshop by the headmaster from a Hong Kong school to explore the concepts and strategies of a self-regulated learning model of classroom practice. There will also be an international and special seminar by educational experts from Finland and Korea. More than 200 workshops for teachers on professional development and model classrooms, plus a media and educational technology exhibition are also available.
